I. The Department

We continue to push forward to provide the best possible service to the community. We now have Paramedic Personnel on duty on a limited availability during operational hours of 8 am, to 5 pm. When residing over night at the Fire Station they will also be available for off hour response. We have received the First of two ZOLL E Series EKG/Defib Units from the JPA.

On June 28, 2017, the JPA adopted the agreement between the MFPD and JPA to provide Engine based ALS Services and increase our annual supply stipend from \$5,000 to \$7,500 annually.

We are now also adding a Fire Marshall to the Operational Matrix of the Fire District Command Structure. An Agenda Item for this change has been submitted for this addition. I would like to introduce Dion Nugent. Dion is well known throughout the county. He provides these same services to Garden Valley and Diamond Springs Fire Departments.

The MFPD will be researching and developing an operational consolidation agreement with Garden Valley Fire. I believe this will be a positive impact for the cost of training and staffing.

II. The Station

Electrical repairs have been completed with the installation of a dedicated circuit for the Crews Quarters and Class Room. The electrical line and light for the flag pole has also been repaired. West side lawn sprinklers have been repaired.

III. INFORMATION:

Saturday August 12, 2017. The MFPD will be hosting Fire Ops 101. We invite the board of Directors and the Residents of the Hill to come to the Fire Station and take part in mock Fire Ground Operations. We will have participants don Fire Fighter Protective equipment including full SCBA and going on air, Mock Structure Fire entry, pulling and deploying hose lines, fire search and rescue with the Thermal imaging camera, cutting fire line and extending hose lines for wildland fire attack. Conducting CPR and Cardiac Rescue.

September 22-24, 2017 The MFPD will be hosting a Swift Water Technician Course.

The MFPD has Green metal address markers for sale. \$15.00 apiece, or \$25.00 for the Fire District to come out and install in a reasonable location at the street end of your driveway.

Pilots Association is hosting Aircraft Display Days 10am to 2pm, at the Airport, 7/15-16/2017

MVFA is sponsoring Community Cleanup Day this weekend. Dumpsters will be in the gravel parking lot next to the station. Elderly residents who need to get rid of unwanted items and who do not have the means to do so can contact the Fire Station for assistance.

MS75 has a Pancake Breakfast July 22nd and is Sponsoring the National Night Out August 1st.
