
SUPPORT GROUP RESPONSIBILITIES

SUPPORT GROUP OPERATIONS

- First responder to the station is Station Manager (SM)
- Station Manager-
 - Assesses the situation and resources needed and obtains additional as required
 - Initiates Incident Report and accounts for responders
 - Assigns responders to activities
 - Tracks activities and resources while maintaining presence at station for communication
- Responders perform actions as needed
- At conclusion of the incident all report to the station for accounting and release
