



## Mosquito Road Bridge Project Outreach

Shimmick would like to thank the El Dorado County and Mosquito Road community for their continued support in the Construction of the new Mosquito Road Bridge. We plan to utilize these mailbox fliers to maintain transparency with upcoming notices and impacts, as well as keeping the community alert and safe from foreseeable project inconveniences.

### **Important Information/what work to expect:**

- The existing road closure on Mosquito Road is expected to be lifted on August 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Though the road will be reopened, please expect delays from traffic control and piloting cars mobilizing equipment along the project site for the next multiple months.
- Alternate routes are still highly suggested for use while construction is continuing throughout the week. For safety purposes as well as community convenience we recommend the continue use of Rock Creek Road when necessary.
- Mosquito Road will be lined with additional signage and warnings to alert travelers of potential construction zones or active work areas for transparency and awareness.
- When traveling on Mosquito Road, please take extra precautions toward speed limits and blind turns to maximize safety efforts for everyone involved.
- Over the next few months, the project team will be performing access road construction in order to get the crews into the bridge and drilling work. You may see trucks hauling rock or soil along the road and dirt moving equipment on the site. Our goal is to install the access roads and get baserock installed on the roads so we can work through the wetter months.
